



Pre-op skin protection before surgical procedures

Getting ready for surgery

- If you plan to wash your hair, use your regular shampoo; then rinse your hair and body thoroughly to remove any shampoo residue
- Wash your face with your regular soap or water only
- Completely rinse your body with water from the neck down
- Put it directly on your skin or on a wet washcloth and wash gently
 - Move away from the water when using it - to avoid rinsing it off too soon
- Rinse with warm water and keep out of eyes, ears and mouth
 - If it gets in eyes, ears or mouth, rinse out right away
- Dry your skin with a towel
- ***Do not use your regular soap after applying and rinsing with Hibiclens®***
- Do not apply lotions or deodorants to the cleaned body area



General Information when using Hibiclens®:

- If it gets onto cloth, do not bleach it!
 - Using bleach may leave a brown stain
- Can be found at Target, Walmart, Walgreens, CVS, Rite-Aid, etc.
 - ~\$9-12
- Is available over the counter - a prescription is not required for use.
